The American government wages a secret war against Mexican drug cartels who are trafficking terrorists across the border in Taylor Sheridan's (*Hell or High Water*, *Wind River*) muscular political-thriller.

Dir. Kevin Macdonald. UK/USA, 2018. 2h. Starring Whitney Houston, Cissy Houston, Robyn Crawford. Oscar-winning filmmaker Kevin Macdonald examines the life and career of iconic singer Whitney Houston. An absorbing documentary featuring revealing interviews with those who knew her best.



### The Bookshop (PG)

Dir. Isabel Coixet. Spain/UK, 2017. 1h 53m. Starring Emily Mortimer, Bill Nighy, Patricia Clarkson. A small seaside town in 50s Norfolk faces the strains of cultural change when a woman opens a bookshop selling modern literature. A subtly subversive period drama adapted from Penelope Fitzgerald's novel.



### Carry Greenham Home (15)

Dir. Beeban Kidron, Amanda Richardson. UK, 1983. 1h 9m. A seminal work of British feminism on film depicting the bravery, creativity, and humour of the women at Greenham Common Peace Camp, who formed a human chain to protest nuclear weapons at RAF Greenham Common in Berkshire.

Dir. Ol Parker. UK/USA, 2018. 1h 54m. Starring Meryl Streep, Pierce Brosnan, Amanda Seyfried, Colin Firth, Lily James, Stellan Skarsgård, Julie Walters, Dominic Cooper, Cher. Return to the sun-soaked island of Kalokairi for another irresistible musical based on the songs of ABBA.



### Mary Shelley (12A)

Dir. Haifaa al-Mansour. Ireland/UK, 2017. 2h 1m. Starring Elle Fanning, Maisie Williams, Douglas Booth. A luscious period drama about the author of Frankenstein and her fiery marriage with poet Percy Shelley. A red-blooded tribute to her bravery and craft by Saudi Arabian director, Haifaa al-Mansour.



### Postcards from the 48% (PG)

Dir. David Wilkinson. UK, 2018. 1h 54m. Starring Patrick Stewart, Miriam Margolyes, Ian McEwan. A crowd-funded documentary made by and featuring those who voted Remain in the EU referendum. The film aims to show the other 27 EU Member States why they are continuing the fight to remain.

The writer of *Taxi Driver* directs this transfixing thriller about a crisis of faith.
